#### 9:00 Mutton Island Site Visit



We will be visiting Mutton Island, an uninhabited island located about 1 km off the coast of Galway City. Mutton island is connected to the mainland by a causeway. It is home to a sewage treatment plant and a heritage lighthouse, both of which are not normally accessible to the public. There will be site tours in two small groups. **Please wear high-visibility vests and sensible shoes**.

After the visit, we will travel to the Galway City Council offices to meet with Galway City and Irish Water representatives, followed by lunch.

The Mutton Island causeway is about 30 minutes' walk or a short taxi drive from the hotels in Salthill and the city centre. However, a bus transfer will be available from the University/the hotels in Salthill to the Galway City Council offices and back to the University of Galway.
